

BOWL OFF

NSW COMMUNITY CRICKET CUP

In the state where no game can be played but both team are at the venue, A bowl off is to be commenced.

A coin toss is to be commenced to determine which team bowls first.

Teams alternate bowling 1 ball each at an unguarded wicket from full pitch length.

If the wicket is broken, the team receives 1 point. If the wicket is missed, 0 points are scored. The wicket is broken when at least one bail is completely removed from the top of the stumps, or one or more stumps is removed from the ground.

After each team has had 5 balls total, a winner shall be determined by which team has the most points.

If scores are tied after 5 balls, sudden death rules will apply.

If all members have bowled in the bowl off and scores are still tied, the order will restart, and teams must bowl in the exact order of 1st round.
